We have seen a reduction of 42% since 2013.

We currently save the equivalent of **150 Olympic swimming pools** per year through efficient irrigation practices.

We also engage annually in alien clearing on Paarl Mountain Reserve to help eradicate alien species and **preserve the natural biodiversity**.

Carbon footprint

We have been actively measuring our carbon footprint since 2015 as part of the Confronting Climate Change initiative.

We have seen great reductions in the use of synthetic fertilisers and our current usage is well below the industry norm:

1.82 kg per Ton of fruit
